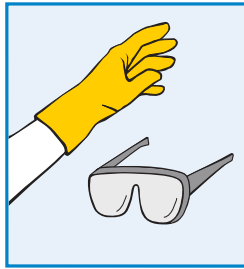
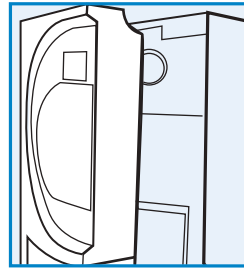


INTEGRA MILK SYSTEM CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

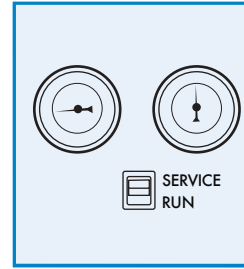
- **USE HOT WATER** dispensed from the machine.
- **DO NOT USE COLD WATER**, cleaner is not effective in cold water.
- Use gloves and eye protection when cleaning machine.
- Powder contains chlorine. Solution may bleach/stain countertop or clothing.
- Use only Concordia approved cleaning chemicals! Use of substitutes may void your warranty and may not sanitize your milk system.



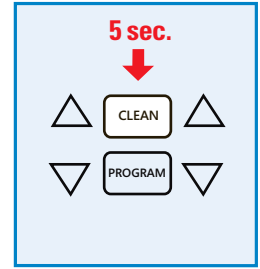
1. Use appropriate eye protection and the provided gloves while cleaning the machine.



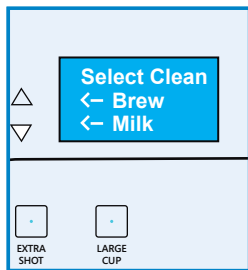
2. Open the left door.



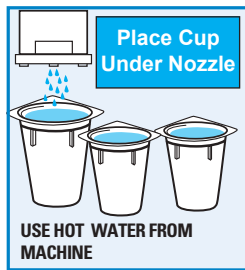
3. Push the service switch to the "Service" position.



4. Press and **HOLD** **CLEAN** button until **SELECT CLEAN** is displayed.



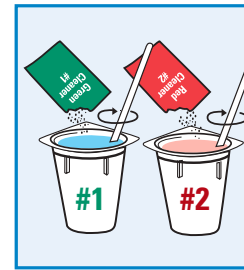
5. When **SELECT CLEAN** is displayed, press the lower arrow to begin the milk clean process.



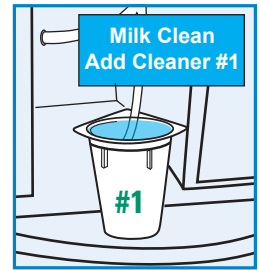
6. When **PLACE CUP UNDER NOZZLE** is displayed, place the first cleaning cup under the nozzle and press the **CLEAN** button. The cup will be filled with hot water. Repeat this process with the other two cups. The machine will beep after each cup is filled.



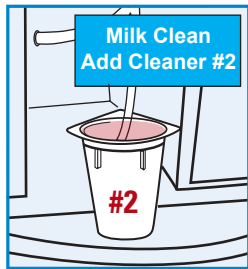
7. Remove milk from the refrigeration unit.



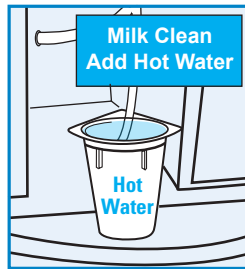
8. Slowly pour **Cleaner #1** into the first cup, and mix the cleaner and water thoroughly to ensure that the cleaning powder is completely dissolved. Repeat this process with **Cleaner #2** and the second cup of hot water.



9. When the message **MILK CLEAN ADD CLEANER #1** is displayed, place the cup with **Cleaner #1** on the drain grate and place the milk pick-up tube in the cup, and press the **CLEAN** button.



10. When the message **MILK CLEAN ADD CLEANER #2** is displayed, place the cup with **Cleaner #2** on the drain grate and place the milk pick-up tube in the cup, and press the **CLEAN** button.



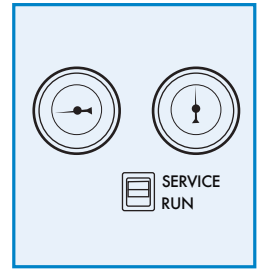
11. When the message **MILK CLEAN ADD HOT WATER** is displayed, place the cup with hot water on the drain grate and place the milk pick-up tube in the cup, and press the **CLEAN** button.

13. Using a clean cloth, re-insert milk pick-up tube into the milk container, and place milk container in the refrigeration unit.



14. Push the service switch to the "Run" position. Secure cleaning materials and close all doors. The milk clean process is now complete.



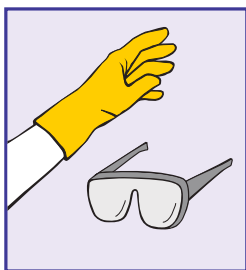
Caution!

- Read and observe all safety precautions listed on packaging.

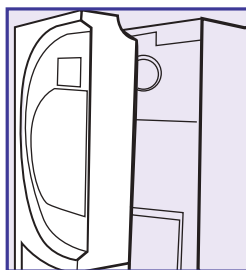

INTEGRA BREW SYSTEM CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

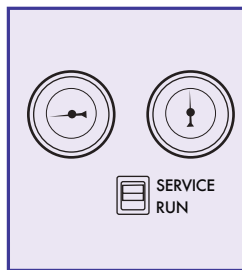
- Perform once a day.
- Use gloves and eye protection when cleaning machine.



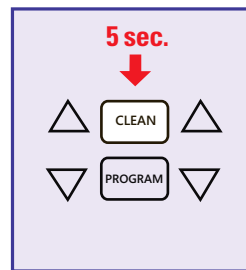
1. Use appropriate eye protection and the provided gloves while cleaning the machine.



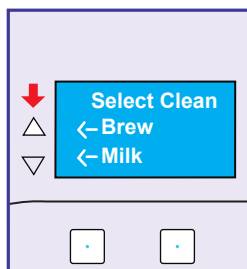
2. Open the left door.



3. Push the service switch to the "Service" position. Close left door.



4. Press and **HOLD** **CLEAN** button until **SELECT CLEAN** is displayed.



5. When **SELECT CLEAN** is displayed, press the upper arrow to begin the brew clean process.



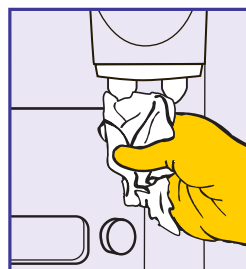
6. When **SWEEP BREWER** is displayed, use the brush provided to sweep coffee grounds from the brew chamber area. Close left door.



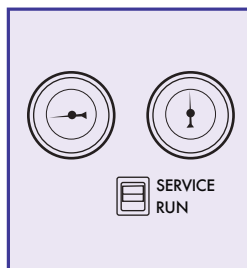
7. When **INSERT TABLET** is displayed, open left door and place one cleaning tablet in the brew chamber. **DO NOT** mistakenly place the tablet in the grounds chute. Close left door to begin the brew clean process.



8. When the brew clean process is finished, open both front doors of the machine to clean the drain tray and grate. Remove and empty grounds bin.



9. Wash delivery nozzles with hot, soapy water, and clean with sanitizer*.



10. Push the service switch to the "Run" position. Secure cleaning materials and close all doors. The brew clean process is now complete.



11. Clean the machine exterior.
